## INTERNATIONAL ART BIENNALE

**I.** The natural environment defined by the Danube, the region’s history, culture and artistic traditions of Baja, predestine the city to be the home of the biennale. The city that lies nearly at the midpoint of the Danube is one of the most important and ancient cities in the southern region of the river, which interconnects several countries. The biennial aims to provide every two years a review of the water and life-themed works of the Danube countries.

### **II. APPLICANTS**

Applications can be accepted from Germany, Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, Croatia, Serbia, Romania, Bulgaria, Moldova and Ukraine in the following categories:

- **painting**
- **graphics**

The artworks may not be prepared before 2015.

You can apply to the competition with the digital photograph of your work by **15 October, 2017** at [vizeselet@ejf.hu](mailto:vizeselet@ejf.hu). Each artist can apply with the photographs of two works. A professional jury will select the artworks to be exhibited based on the digital photographs.

### III. AWARDS

By the decision of the jury a first, a second, a third, and two special awards will be given.

- I. Award 120 000 HUF
- II. Award 100 000 HUF
- III. Award 80 000 HUF
- Special award – participation in the IX. Caffart International Artists' Colony
- Special award – Individual exhibition at the Picture Gallery of István Nagy at Baja

### IV. DETAILS OF ARTWORKS

- The original flat-type units can be: max. 120 cm x 120 cm
- Graphic artworks can be accepted only in ready to exhibition way – standard size passepartouted (50x70 cm or 70x100 cm), or in case of individual sizes in frames, covered by glass – with standard subtitleing. Only artworks, made by classical graphic techniques can be accepted.
- Parameters of the artwork's photograph: resolution of 72 x 72 dpi, picture size of at most 1600 x 1200 pixel, color depth of 24 bit/pixel, max. 0,5 MB file size, file type: JPG. At the naming of the digital reproduction please follow the example, accentuated letters are forborne!  
Example: name of creator\_title of the work\_size\_technique\_the year of creation.  
Please indicate the following data next to the pictures: name of the creator, title of the work, size, technique, year of creation.

### V. DEADLINES

- The deadline for submitting the digital photographs is: **15 October, 2017**
